- *Practice these patterns in school plain notebook.*

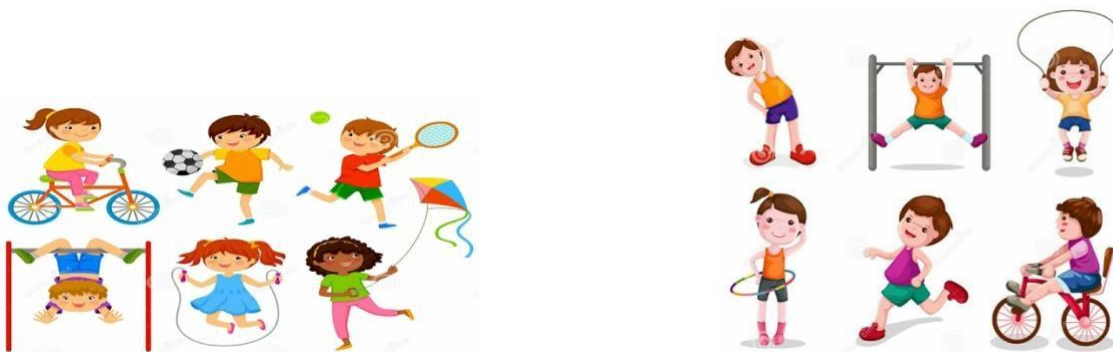
- *Do Pages 1 to 10 in Fun With English Book.*

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

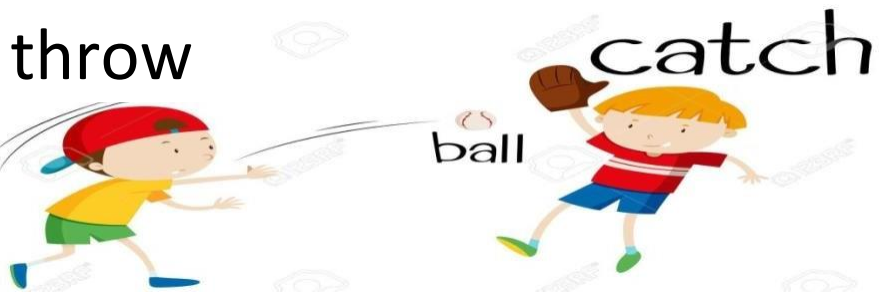


- *Make your child do simple exercises , workouts along with you which will improve flexibility and motor skills.*

- *Play with your child with a ball. Help him/ her kick, throw, catch , dribble the ball.*

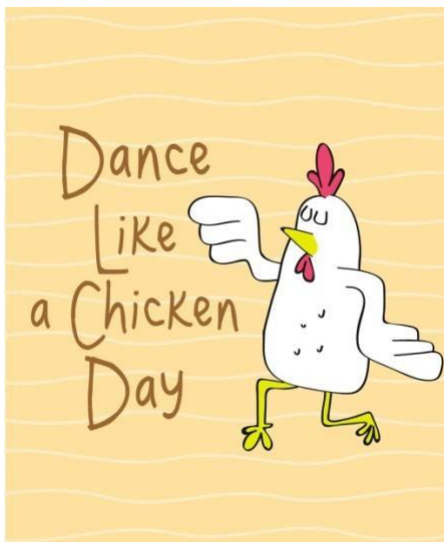


DANCE

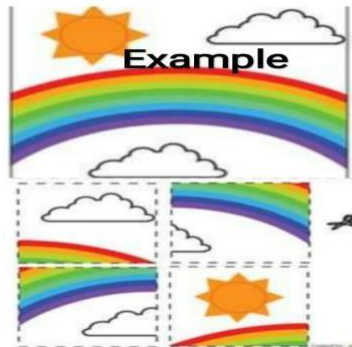
CREATIVE AND EXPRESSIVE ART

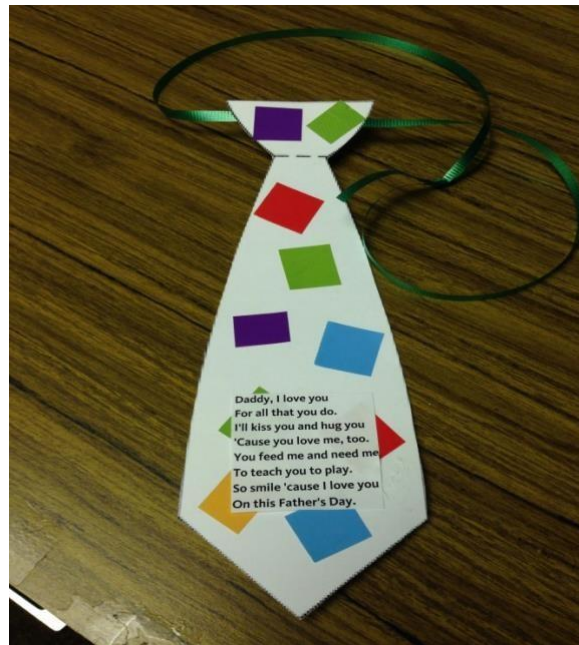



ACTIVITY FATHER'S DAY
